Stage 2 Forces and Function Incursion

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

In our MAPPEN unit, students have been learning about 'Forces and Functions'. This incursion will allow students to see how contact and non-contact forces affect an object's motion. They will observe forces first-hand including friction and gravity and how these forces are challenging their movements by constructing and racing billy carts. Students will design and build their very own rocket before launching their spacecraft into the sky above the rooftops using a specially designed high-pressure industrial rocket launcher. Students will also identify the properties of forces by getting their hands dirty to make slime.
