Cross Country

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Blue Haven Public School's annual Cross Country will be held on **Friday 26th March 2021**.

All children are expected to participate by either walking or running. If your child is not able to participate, please let your child's teacher know in writing, with a suitable reason.

Please ensure that your child has the following equipment for the day:

- school hat - running shoes - drink bottle - own sunscreen

There will be a parent viewing area set up on the oval and netball courts.

Please note, due to the current COVID safety guidelines, the following restrictions will apply;

- All parents/caregivers will need to sign in with the COVID safe app and sign-on sheet
- Maintain social distancing of 1.5m spacing from other adults, when within the school
- A limit of 2 adults to attend per child
- **Only** attend the races that include your child/ren

Normal classes will still operate while different age groups are running.

Below is a timetable for the day. These are **approximate** times only.

***Please note that 8 and 9-year-old competitors will be timed to determine the six fastest students. This is due to them being required to run together in the same division at the Zone Central Coast Carnival.**

The carnival will run as follows;

9.30-9.50	All 10-year old's (two laps)	11.30-11.50	Year 1 (one lap)
9.50-10.10	All 9-year old's (two laps)	11.50-12.10	Kindergarten (one lap)
10.10-10.30	All 8-year old's (two laps)	12:10-12:30	Local Preschools

***If your child is in Years 3-6, they will need to carry their own asthma puffers. K-2 students will have puffers kept in the medical tent, if required.**
